What You Can Do At Your School or Community

- ✓ Wear the color **ORANGE**
- ✓ Write the word **"UNITY"** on your hand, your notebook, or on a poster to hang in your locker or hallway
- ✓ Hang a banner with the word **UNITY** and ask everyone to sign
- ✓ Create and wear an orange **"unity ribbon"**

To create your own ribbons., purchase a spool of orange ribbon (5/8" wide) at a craft or dollar store. Cut into 12" strips. With a black marker, write UNITY, "The End of Bullying Begins With Me," or create your own bullying prevention message for the ribbons.
